Our Impact

Services to Children & Youth

Our primary focus is always on serving children, youth, and their families, so they can do better. That means we are constantly striving to enhance our club and mentoring programs. Over the past year:

- We improved our responsiveness and flexibility for families enrolling their children in our mentoring programs. A new pre-assessment tool helps us find the best program to fit the needs of the child and family.
- As part of the United Way's All In For Youth initiative, we expanded to include 5 new school sites where we provide after school programming and mentoring supports. This enables us to reach more kids who might be facing the challenges of poverty or struggling academically.
- Our Clubs have implemented Teen Nights to provide more specific programming and are placing more emphasis on our Torch and Keystone programs to teach kids about leadership and giving back to the community. We also ran the second Teen Takeover for our youth and the kids reached through that event doubled from the year prior.
- We have been working with external programmers to meet the needs and interests of our kids while stretching their imaginations. For example, we've brought in Art Start and Cultural Coaches from the Family Centre, Concordia's Drama Club, and No More Excuses.
- Our intramural program between Clubs and our OST sites has been a focus to encourage new friendships and foster belonging.
- A youth development team was created to work on the Youth In Care projects for Alberta and Edmonton and also the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Canada's The Circle program.
- We continued to work on a strategy to serve boys who are currently waiting for a mentor. The new Touchdown program is just one example. Our Engagement Manager is part of the National Mentoring Boys Committee as this is an issue faced by organizations across the country.

Volunteer Stewardship

We want all volunteers to feel engaged in the organization though all aspects of their journey with us and remain connected to us for many years. Over the past year:

- We improved the time it takes a volunteer to go through our application process. Our goal is to match a volunteer to a child in under eight weeks.
- Our relationships have developed with multiple cultural communities. However, with the influx of Syrian newcomers we are working through adjusting to the new landscape. We always strive to provide a diverse population of volunteers to meet the changing demographic of children and youth.
- We continue to focus on strengthening our relationship with our current volunteers so they feel valued and see the impact of the time they spend with our organization.

Community Engagement

It's important for our organization to have a strong communication strategy and continually grow revenue to sustain all aspects of our work. Over the past year:

- The 37th Dream Home Lottery was a success and exceeded our fundraising goal.
- We started work to develop a new website and messaging to better reflect the diversity of programming and the funds related to those programs.
- Our 100 Men 100 Days campaign kicked off 2017 and was successful in recruiting over 100 male applicants.
- A tool kit for community-driven fundraisers was completed and is available to anyone looking to host a fundraiser and donate the proceeds to BGCBigs. This was a significant source of funding this year and we will continue to explore how to bolster this area of revenue.
- The annual Golf Tournament and Lobster Lovers Feast were both successful. Despite the decline in our economy, we were fortunate to have our sponsors and donors follow-through with their commitment to these events.

Leadership & Partnerships

BGCBigs continues to be involved with many like-minded organizations to advance the mentoring movement in Alberta. Over the past year:

- We increased supervision and direction to the staff in our satellite offices in areas of service delivery and support services. It's important that our programs meet the needs of each market and we continue to work with those communities to improve.
- In partnership with Alberta Mentoring Partnership, we established the Rural and Remote Committee to explore a more collaborative response to youth mentoring in Canada.
- Our staff were highly involved in the development and implementation of the All In For Youth initiative. We are proud to be playing a key role in service delivery.

Organizational Capacity

Our ever-growing capacity as an organization is key to ensuring we can meet all our other goals and mandates. Over the past year:

- Our Board of Directors has met with the Inner City Children's Program Board and the City of Edmonton's Multicultural Department.
- Our Human Resources Department continues to ensure that current staff or staff being hired are being developed as leaders.
- We started working to create an overarching Evaluation Framework that will help to ensure BGCBigs is providing quality, evidence-based programming.

Partnership Highlights



Government of Alberta

We are grateful for the support of many Government of Alberta ministries and departments including Alberta Education, Alberta Human Services and Alberta Culture. In addition to core funding to support our work in rural communities and youth in care in Edmonton, we received funding from Alberta Culture to renovate our Kinsmen Club, ensuring that our children have safe spaces after school and during the summer.

All In For Youth

Thanks to funding from the Edmonton Community Foundation, the United Way of the Alberta Capital Region, and the City of Edmonton, BGCBigs expanded to 5 new sites with out-of-school time programming and mentoring support. This expansion is part of our role in the All In For Youth initiative to get children and youth successfully through their education journey to high school completion.




HSBC Bank of Canada
